Workers' Compensation Act

FIREFIGHTERS' PRIMARY SITE CANCER REGULATION

Definitions

1 In this Regulation,

- (a) "Act" means the *Workers' Compensation Act*;
- (b) "non-smoker" means an individual who has not smoked a tobacco product in the 10 years prior to the date of diagnosis of a primary site cancer.

Designated cancers and periods of employment

2 For the purpose of section 24.1(4) of the Act, the primary site cancers and the minimum period of exposure for each disease are the following:

PRIMARY SITE CANCERS	MINIMUM PERIOD OF REGULAR EXPOSURE TO THE HAZARDS OF A FIRE SCENE
Primary leukemia	5 years
Primary site brain cancer	10 years
Primary site bladder cancer	15 years
Primary site lung cancer in non-smokers	15 years
Primary site ureter cancer	15 years
Primary site kidney cancer	20 years
Primary site colorectal cancer	20 years
Primary site testicular cancer	20 years
Primary site esophageal cancer	25 years
A primary non-Hodgkin's lymphoma	20 years
A primary site prostate cancer	15 years
A primary site skin cancer	15 years
A primary site breast cancer	10 years
Multiple myeloma	15 years
